2011 CBF PRE-APPROVED NPC LIST

Teams must try and find NPCs from this pre-approved list. People on the list have the right to decline a request from a team.

If a team has contacted at least 50% of the people on the NPC list and found no one to be their NPC, they may ask the CBF Board to approve an individual who is not on the NPC list. The team will be required to submit a list of the people on the list that they contacted.

Each year the pre-approved NPC list will be updated and new applications will be accepted.
