## SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES

At 5-level at unfav if we've shown inv+ opposite opening bid (3m) $3 \mathrm{Y} / \mathrm{X}(5 \mathrm{~m}) \mathrm{P}$ - forcing at unfavorable
Pass then pull is stronger than initial action
