### Roche – Lyder

Strong Club – 17+ if balanced; may be less HCP if unbalanced

1D Opening – usually 2+D 10-16. Can be a singleton only 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> non-vulnerable

#### Artificial Responses to 1D

2H Balanced Game Invitation 12-13 No Major

2S Either GF with D support or both minors less than invitational

2D Opening (A) 10-16 and 3 suited short in D

(B) 5-10 Simple Multi – Weak 2 in a Major – 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> – Non vul

2H Opening (A) when using 2D as Multi 2H is 3 suited with short D – promises 4H

(B) 5-10 Weak 2 – usually 6 cards

2S Opening (A) 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> seat when using 2D as Multi 2S is a good 3D opening

(B) 3<sup>rd</sup> seat - when using 2D as Multi 2S is 5+S and 4+ minor 5-10HCP

(C) 5-10 Weak 2 – usually 6 cards

Defense to Multi 2D – Option 1 or 2
