CBC 2023 -

- Cathy Walsh and Shelley Burns worked on shortening schedule by one day. Negatives, CNTC A 2
 day final was request by players, but we will shorten to a 1 day final this year. Move CWTC playoffs
 closer to CMTC so that it is more convenient for players.
- Shelley feels not playing on long weekend is better than moving the schedule to play over the long weekend. Also, hotel rates are higher on the long weekend.
- Regional schedule needs to be revised.
- CWTC and CSTC round robin will be played on Real Bridge, semi-final and final will be in person in Niagara Falls. Masterpoint status is unknown for this format. Mid January for online Round Robin.
- Fees were \$180 a day online. Prior to 2019 CBC, the Board had voted to make them, \$240 per day. 2023 fees will be:
 - \$240 for Championship events.
 - B & C \$180 per day. No world qualification.
 - COPC and CIPC -- \$30 per person per session.
 - Regional fees -- \$20 per person per session.

CW —would like 8 teams to allow event to go ahead. ID — there are issues with not sending teams to World events.

Everyone, seems OK with 10 days schedule and not condensing to 9 days.

Logistics of CBC & meetings:
