OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
1-level = 8(7)+; 2-level = sound (new suit force); Cue= good hand almost always with support; JQ = mixed raise
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15+ - 18; systemics as Front of Card
Balance 1NT = 12(11)-14
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
1-suit = preemptive
Jump to 4m / naturl. Pre-empt = m + M
2NT jump overcall = 2 lowest
Reopen: in passout jump is intermediate
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Michaels Cue-bid (1z-[2z])
2M - [3M] asks stopper
2m/2H...jump to 3S = intermediate invite
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Vs STR. X = 4M + longer m; 2C=MM; 2D=Multi; 2M = suit + minor; 2NT = minors
Vs WEAK X= good hand; 2C = some 1-suiter; 2D =MM; 2M = suit + minor
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
X is takeout; 2NT resp Lebensohl if available
Simple 2NT overall = natu'l., 16-18
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Vs strong 1C; MATHE X=majors; 1NT = minors; J = weak

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
5+ Maj. (semi-f. 1NT resp) 1 st & 2 nd ; occas. 4-card in 3rd
Jacoby 2NT; BERGEN (3C=limit); 3NT resp as 'big fit' but limited contr.; 1S - 3H = nat'l, invite
Drury (pH); Fit jumps / 1M
INVERTED minors (thru 2NT or 3m); 2NT resp. (nf.); 1D - 3C (natural; inv.)
1NT (15-17); Transfers & 2S = range ask
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
Over opps 1NT, Multi-LANDY (2C=MM; 2D=1M; 2M = that suit + minor)
1m - 1M - 2NT ; resp. rebids are TRANSFERS
1r - P - 1z - 1NT; both minors artif.= 2-way NMF
Modified INGBERMAN after opener's reverse; cheapest of 4 th suit or 2NT may be weak runout
DON'T over penalty X of our 1NT
Unusu. Vs Unus. (lower = hearts)
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
Pass is Forcing at game+ level if we have shown GF, Or when earlier inv. was accepted
IMPORTANT NOTES
Carriere(very aggressive) - Bishop (not so much)
